2016 AIM State Singles Championship - Wednesday, July 20th

- 100 Target Event (16 yard) that runs concurrent with Youth Team Event
- AIM/ATA Membership required to be eligible for AIM Trophies

Categories: The shooter's individual category will remain the same throughout the target year for all events, awards and AIM Annual Teams. **NEW MEMBERS** - Age category is based on your age the day you join the ATA. **RENEWING MEMBERS** - Age category is based on your age as of 9-1-2015.

Category	Age Range
Pre-Sub	Age 11 & Under
Sub-Junior	Age 12-14
Junior	Age 15-17
Junior Gold	Age 18-22

- No additional fees or target cost – all fees listed under Event #1
- Pre-Subs would be registered as Sub-Jr. for non-AIM Events
- Individual Awards Sub-Jr. & Junior; Champion – Fifth
- Individual Awards Pre-Sub & Senior; Champion, Runner-Up, Third
- Team Awards – each Category; Champion, Runner-Up, Third

2016 ND AIM State Handicap / Doubles Championship – Thursday, July 21st **Events #3 & #4**

- 100 Target Event that runs concurrent with Event #3 & #4
- AIM/ATA Membership required to be eligible for AIM Trophies
- No additional fees or target cost – all fees listed under Event #3 & #4
- Handicap Individual Awards Sub-Jr. & Junior; Champion – Fifth
- Handicap Individual Awards Pre-Sub & Senior; Champion, Runner-Up, Third
- Doubles Individual Awards Sub-Jr. & Junior; Champion, Runner-Up, Third
- Doubles Individual Awards Pre-Sub & Senior; Champion & Runner-Up
- ND AIM Championship Trophies and Scores are separate from the ND State Shoot.

All AIM Trophies will be mailed out following the shoot, all ties will be decided by reverse scoring.

AIM Singles, Handicap and Doubles shooters must sign up on participation sheet to be eligible for AIM Trophies.

ND AIM MSE's (Monthly Shooting Events)

March, April, May, June and July

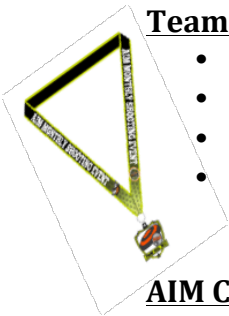
- 100 Targets Events
- Any ATA registered Shoot
- No shoot in the area; ATA Club may register a day for an AIM MSE event
- Coaches must report team scores on line
- Individual AIM winners are processed by ATA through an AIM/ATA number

Individual MSE

Shooters can compete as many times as they would like within that month by shooting at any ATA registered shoots. Individual's high score shot for each month will be chosen as the competition score for that MSE. When an ATA Singles event consists of more than 100 targets, the total score for this event will be averaged for the use of MSE's. Scores that are not whole numbers will be rounded up. Example: A score of 197 out of 200 targets = 98.5% | MSE score rounded up= 99

Team MSE

- Teams consist of five shooters minimum of those who live in the same state.
- Individuals are able to participate on one squad per month for team awards.
- Must shoot on the same squad, trap field, and on the same day.
- Scores for teams must be entered online using the AIM Coaches Login (set up prior to entering scores).
